## Course Goal

Criminal Justice/Investigation professionals interesting in improving their skills in gathering information through the use of the interview and/or the interrogation process.

Persons wanting to discover how the concept of Subconscious Communication® can assist in the gathering and evaluation of informational data and conquer barriers to truthfulness.

**Upon completing the course, the attendee will have a better understanding of:**

1. Successfully gather information and to evaluate the accuracy of data collected.
2. Recognize non-verbal communication and the role it plays in the communication process.
3. Comprehend key verbal words or phrases that assist in determining deception or involvement in individuals.
4. Utilize conscious and subconscious rapport building to create either a positive or negative environment.
5. Formulate questions and use specific question types so that maximum information might be gained from each response.
6. Manipulate proxemics for utmost benefits.
7. How to use their posture and communication style for maximum results.
8. Create themes and statements to overcome denials and defenses in the Information gathering process.
9. Understand legal issues regarding interviewing and interrogation

There is no cost to the attendees or their agencies, except for per diem, if applicable. This course is limited to 45 students and is open to federal, state and local law enforcement officers. Criminal intelligence analysts, program analysts and military personnel assigned to counterdrug activities in a HIDTA may also attend on a space-available basis.
